COVID-19 COMMUNICATIONS

For Immediate Release: March 22, 2020

The Governor's Office of the State of Ohio has declared a mandatory "Director's Stay At Home" order. This order will go into effect at 11:59 p.m. on Monday, March 23. This means all persons must stay home unless engaged in essential work or activity. Persons who must leave their home for essential activity must maintain social distancing of at least six feet from any other person (with the exception of family or household members).

As outlined in the Director's Orders, essential activities include: Leaving your home for health and safety, necessary supplies and services (groceries), outdoor activity, certain types of work (essential personnel only), and to take care of others.

Please note: Although parks will remain open, all playgrounds will be CLOSED.
