City of Perrysburg Police Division COVID-19 Updates

The Governor's Office of the State of Ohio is urging all Ohioans to take actions to help minimize the spread of COVID-19. In an effort to reduce exposure of the virus to City employees, the City of Perrysburg Police Division will be taking all reports (that do not require an in-person response) over the phone. The shift supervisor will make the final decision on whether or not the call requires an in-person response. The public is encouraged to call the non-emergency number (419-872-8001) for non-emergency situations, rather than coming to the station.

Additionally, the City of Perrysburg Police Division will not be responding to private property crash reports unless there is an injury or it is a hit/skip. Those involved in the private property crash are asked to exchange information with the other driver.
