City of Perrysburg Providing Additional Refuse Service at the Department of Public Service

Due to COVID-19, the City has suspended large item pickup during refuse collection in an effort to reduce exposure of the virus to City employees.

However, beginning Monday, April 6, residents may bring large items and extra trash to the Department of Public Service, located at 11980 Roachtown Road. This service is available to all City residents during the COVID-19 public health emergency, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE: This service is for City of Perrysburg residents only. There is one large dumpster where residents may drop off large items and two smaller dumpsters where residents may drop off extra bagged trash. All of the dumpsters are labeled. The same rules for curbside large collection items apply when dropping off large items in the dumpster (NO construction materials, flammables, tires, etc.).
