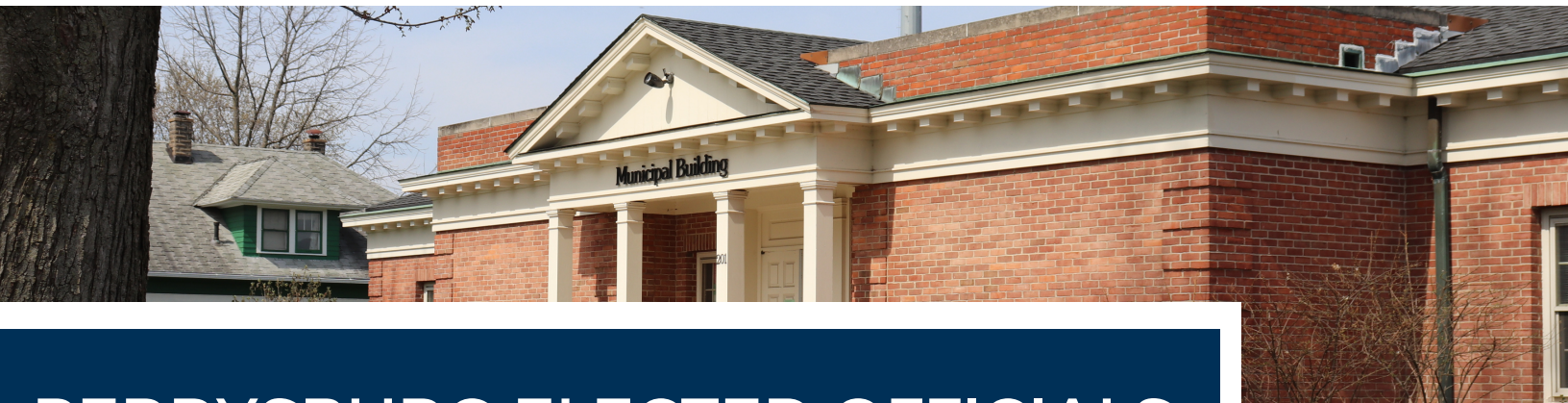

CAMPS AND PROGRAMS INFORMATION

In the following pages, you will find all of the camps and programs that we are offering this summer. Camps occur within one week and sometimes even just one day and time. Programs are repeated weekly throughout the summer. The prices you see are the total cost of the activity regardless of how many weeks you participate.

As you read through the camps and programs, you will notice some changes from our previous program guides. First, the activities are organized by category that corresponds to the same categories found on our registration page. We encourage you to explore every category as you never know what you may find! Activities are then listed alphabetically within their category.

All ages are listed next to the left margin. In order to register for a program, a child must be within the age range listed at some point in June, July, or August this summer. While a few of our camps are listed as “boys” or “girls”, we encourage families to sign up for anything they want to. We do not have gender filters on any of our activities.

We have also listed the location of each activity for your planning purposes. Most of our activities take place in our Recreation Building or on the grounds at Municipal Park. The code that you see for each activity can be used to register online, but you can also search for the activity.

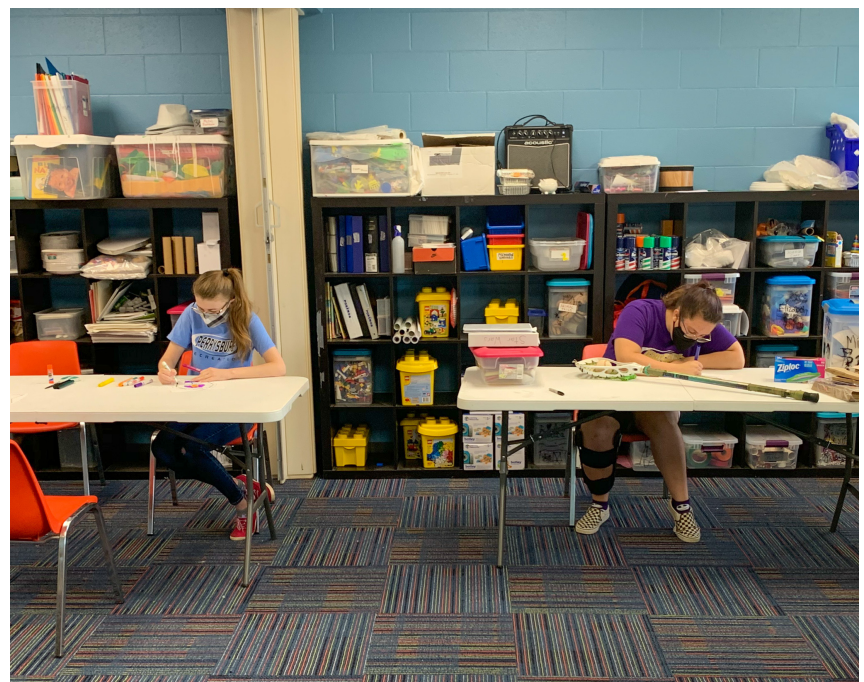
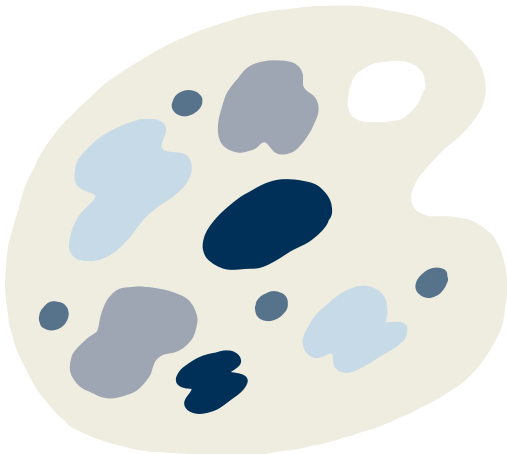
