# REGISTRATION INFORMATION

We are once again utilizing RecDesk for online registration. All registrations must be made online. You can find all activities and register here.

City of Perrysburg residents have priority registration dates and lower costs for programs. However, all are welcome to register for our programs as non-residents, including many free programs. Please note that Perrysburg Township residents are NOT City of Perrysburg residents. Children that attend Perrysburg Schools are not necessarily City of Perrysburg residents.



When a new account is created in RecDesk, it will automatically check the address to see if it is a part of the City of Perrysburg. Your profile will show a green box labeled "Resident" next to your address if you are a city resident.

If RecDesk does not correctly identify you as a resident, this can be easily corrected. Please send an email to: recreation@ci.perrysburg.oh.us.

City of Perrysburg residents may begin registering for activities on April 1. Non-residents may begin registering for activities on April 15.

Most activities will allow registration all the way up until the last date the activity takes place. We have open registration all summer long.


