280.01 ESTABLISHMENT; PURPOSE.

There is hereby created and established a Citizen's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee, the purpose of which Committee, as an adjunct of the City Administration, shall be to guide the development of parks and upon the request of the Mayor or Council the Committee may study the recreational programs in an advisory capacity to Council and the City Administration in the areas of construction of facilities, preservation and development of ecological programs within the parks and the enhancement of recreational programs for citizens of all ages, rendering periodic reports and recommendations to Council and the Administration as it is deemed necessary. (Ord. 140-88. Passed 11-15-88.)

280.02 MEMBERSHIP.

The Citizen's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall consist of eleven members, all of whom shall be residents of the City and two of whom shall be high school students. Also serving as ex-officio members of the Committee shall be the Chairperson of the Recreation Committee of Council and the Superintendent of Parks, Land and Trees of the City, (Ord. 8-86. Passed 2-18-86.)

280.03 TERMS; VACANCIES.

The term of the members of the Citizen's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall be three years, except the members who are high school students, whose term shall be one year. Three members of the first such Committee shall serve for terms ending December 31, 1977; three members for terms ending December 31, 1978; and three members for terms ending December 31, 1979. The two initial high school students shall serve for terms ending June 1, 1987. No member shall be appointed for more than two consecutive full terms. Any member who misses more than three consecutive meetings or more than one-half of the meetings in any calendar year

shall be deemed to have vacated his or her position and shall be replaced. (Ord. 53-96. Passed 4-16-96.)

280.04 APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.

Members of the Citizen's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of Council. (Ord. 18-76. Passed 4-13-76.)

280.05 OFFICERS; MEETINGS; QUORUM.

The Citizen's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall organize annually to elect a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary. Meetings of the Committee shall be scheduled monthly during the months of January, March, May, June, July, August, September, October and December and at such additional times as shall from time to time be provided by the bylaws of the Committee. Six members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. (Ord. 14088. Passed 11-15-88.)

280.06 ASSISTANCE OF CITY DEPARTMENTS.

The Citizen's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee may call upon the various departments of the Municipality for assistance in the performance of its duties and it shall be the duty of such departments to render such assistance to the Committee as may be reasonably anticipated. (Ord. 18-76. Passed 4-13-76.)

280.07 REPORTS TO COUNCIL.

The Citizen's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall render to Council an annual report relating to the activities of the Committee and such other periodic reports and recommendations as may be appropriate. (Ord. 18-76. Passed 4-13-76.)

280.08 COMPENSATION.

Members of the Citizen's Park and Recreation Advisory Committee shall serve without compensation. (Ord. 18-76. Passed 4-13-76.)
