

**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**PERRYSBURG CITY COUNCIL**

**JULY 7, 2015**

Mayor Olmstead called the public hearing to order at 6:25 p.m. Present were Council Members Todd Grayson, John Kevern, Tom Mackin, Jim Matuszak, Tim McCarthy, Rick Rettig and Barry VanHoozen (7). Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, David Creps, Finance Director, and Brody Walters, Planning and Zoning Administrator.

The purpose of the hearing was to consider the rezoning of a 3.954 acre portion of a parcel located south of Eckel Junction Road at the southern end of the stubs of Chippewa Lane and Delaware Drive and to the west of Catawba Drive. The current zoning is A1 (Agricultural) and the applicant has requested that it be rezoned to R3 (Single Family Residential). The Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of the zoning change.

Mr. Mackin asked if this is the only part that is zoned that way. Mr. Walters said that the remainder of the property is all appropriately zoned.

There being no further comments, the public hearing adjourned at 6:28 p.m.
