

**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**PERRYSBURG CITY COUNCIL**

**SEPTEMBER 4, 2018**

Mayor Mackin called the public hearing to order at 6:25 p.m. Present were Council Members Deborah Born, Haraz N. Ghanbari, Jim Matuszak, Jonathan Smith, Barry VanHoozen, and Becky Williams (6). Tim McCarthy was absent (1). Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, David Creps, Clerk of Council, and Brody Walters, Planning and Zoning Administrator.

The purpose of the public hearing was to hear public comment regarding a Special Approval Use for the Perrysburg High School Athletic Facility. They are adding a 12' x 16' athletic storage building. The Planning Commission recommended approval of the Special Approval Use at their July meeting by a 6-0 vote. Mr. Walters said that the lower portion of the building will be masonry and the upper portion will be vinyl. Mr. Matuszak asked if this is a booster project, and Mr. Walters said that he is not sure who is funding it. Mr. Ghanbari asked if this is to be constructed by Penta students, and Mr. Walters said that it will be. Ms. Born asked how the residents feel about it. Mr. Walters said that they received several phone calls from neighbors who were concerned about the location and the building materials. However, once they found it that the structure is internal to the site and what the building materials were, they had no further concerns.

There being no further comments, the hearing adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
