

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING

PERRYSBURG CITY COUNCIL

JULY 30, 2019

Mayor Mackin called the first public hearing to order at 6:15 p.m. Present were Council Members Deborah Born, Jim Matuszak, Tim McCarthy, Jonathan Smith, Barry VanHoozen, Mark Weber and Becky Williams (7). Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, Laura Alkire, Law Director, David Creps, Clerk of Council, and Mark Easterling, Planning and Zoning Administrator.

The purpose of the public hearing was to hear public comment regarding a Special Approval Use for the First United Methodist Church, 200 West Second Street. The Special Approval Use is for Institutional Uses and is subject to the general criteria for special approval uses and the specific criteria of Ch. 1235.04(yy). Mr. Easterling stated that the Final Site Plan that triggered the Special Approval Use has already been approved by the Planning Commission and the Historic Landmarks Commission. Mr. Matuszak asked to see the architectural rendering of the building addition.

There being no further comments, the public hearing adjourned at 6:19 p.m.
