



Important Changes to the Non-Resident Refund Form for Refund of Perrysburg Income Tax Related to COVID-19

You must check the box at the top of the Non-Resident Refund Form if any portion of your application for refund is related to your working from home, or another location away from your regular place of work, because of COVID-19.

A refund of the Perrysburg tax withheld, while you worked from home or another location, may not be available until litigation over this issue is completed. See *Buckeye Institute, et al., v. Columbus City Auditor, et al*, Franklin County Common Pleas Court Case No. 20-CV-004301.

The City of Perrysburg will hold your request for refund in a suspended status until this litigation is concluded. Should the conclusion of this litigation determine that a refund is allowed, your request for refund will be processed at that time. Should the conclusion of the litigation determine that a refund is not allowed, you will receive a notice from our office indicating a refund is not available to you.
