SPRING CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION

- The annual curbside brush collection occurs in April.
- There is NO fall brush collection.
- Maximum length of brush is twelve (12) feet.
- All brush must be placed at curbside.
- There is no alley collection of brush.
- All brush must be placed in the area between the curb/edge of the street and sidewalk.
- Do not place brush in the street. Brush set in the street is a violation of city ordinance 1086.04 Rule 14 and 15 and is subject to a fine.
- Small twigs may be set out in your personal garbage can. Do not use a city Toter for brush collection.

FALL CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION

- The curbside collection of leaves occurs in October.
- All leaves must be placed in the area between the curb/edge of the street and sidewalk.
- DO NOT place leaf piles further back than 6 feet from the side of the street.
- Do not place leaves in bags or cans, because leaves are collected with a leaf vacuum.
- There is **NO fall brush collection** because the crews and trucks used for leaf collection are the same as used for brush collection.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF BRUSH AND LEAVES

- Do not park beside leaf/brush piles because crews cannot reach the piles for collection.
- Do not pile leaves or brush next to fire hydrants or other obstructions.

- After spring brush collection and fall leaf collection are completed, residents may use RENEWED OUTDOORS, LLC compost facility located at 23691 North Dixie Highway. Their hours from March through December are Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Saturdays 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
- Winter hours of January and February are by appointment only by calling 419.844.736.3964.

YARD FRUIT (STREET FRUIT) COLLECTION

Yard Fruit may be placed in your Refuse Toter year round.

Examples of Yard/Street Fruit include:

- Apples
- Buckeyes
- Maple seed spinners
- Nuts: acorns, hickory and walnut
- Osage oranges
- Peaches
- Pears
- Pine cones
- Seed pods from Catalpa and Locust trees
- Sweet gum tree nutlets

STORM DAMAGE COLLECTION

- Collection of storm damage is at the discretion of the Director of Public Service.
- Consult city web page www.ci.perrysburg.oh.us for information about storm damage collection.

After a moderate storm:

- Crews will pick up storm damage from city trees only, within two (2) days.
- Disposal options for residents after a moderate storm include:
 - City Yard Waste Program
 - RENEWED OUTDOORS compost facility
 - Wood County Landfill 419.352.0180 (Fee charged)
 - Hire a private tree maintenance company
 - Store the brush until the spring brush collection

After a strong storm:

- Crews will attempt to take debris from city street trees and residents’ trees.
- Debris must be at curb within seven (7) days after the storm.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

- Christmas trees are collected curbside the second full week of January on regular refuse collection day.
- Trees must be set to the curb, no alley collection.
- All decorations, lights, tree stands and bags must be removed.
