BATTERIES

Alkaline batteries are classified as non-hazardous and are safe to dispose of in the regular garbage.

- **Rechargeable Batteries must be recycled**

These batteries are classified as household hazardous waste (HHW) and should not be placed in the garbage.

- **Cell phone batteries**

Can be recycled at cell phone stores or stores that accept rechargeable batteries.

- **Lithium button batteries** in electronic items as:
 - Calculators, cameras, greeting cards, hearing aids, and watches
 - “Light up” tennis shoes, television remote controls and toys

Rechargeable batteries

- Battery Packs
- Lithium Ion batteries
- Nickel Metal Hybrid (NiMH)
- Nickel-cadmium (Ni-Cd)
- Portable power tool batteries
- Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA) computer pack, power tools, and toys

- ATV's, boats, cars, motorcycles, and trucks

CELL PHONES

Phone stores and these businesses recycle cell phones:

COMPUTERS

Working and non-working computers and associated equipment may be recycled at:

- Department of Public Service (city residents)
 - *NO CRT monitors*

 - Accepts CRT monitors (fee charged)



EYEGASSES (prescription only)

All local optometrists accept prescription eyeglasses for reuse in the Lions Clubs Sight Program.



CFL'S (compact fluorescent light bulbs)

All fluorescent light bulbs contain mercury vapor and need to be handled carefully. CFL's come in many sizes and shapes. Residents may recycle CFL's at:

CONSTRUCTION & REMODELING MATERIALS

Per City Ordinance, city crews **CANNOT** collect construction/remodeling materials. It is the responsibility of the resident to properly dispose of the materials at a local landfill. Contact for details/fees.

Construction & remodeling materials include but not limited to:

- Bathroom fixtures including: hot tubs, showers, sinks, toilets and vanities
- Bricks, blocks, concrete, stone, and tile
- Cabinets and countertops
- Doors and door framing of all types
- Drywall and lumber of all types
- Fencing of all types
- Landscape pavers and timbers
- Lumber of all types
- Plumbing pipe and fixtures
- Siding of all types



LATEX PAINT

DO NOT pour paint or any other fluids down the street storm drain.

DO NOT place paint in liquid form into the refuse Toter because it makes a mess in the Toter and refuse truck. Latex paint can safely be disposed of at home. Use one of the following disposal methods:

Air Dry Method of Drying Paint

- If there is a small amount of paint left in the can, leave the lid off the can and let it dry out.
- Place the open paint can in a location safe from children/pets so they do not spill/ingest the paint.
- When the paint is dried and hardened, place the can in with regular garbage.

Kitty Litter/Absorbent Method of Drying Paint

- Purchase kitty litter, oil dry, saw dust or absorbent.
- Open the can of unwanted paint. The absorbent will expand in the liquid paint so if it is a full can of paint, pour half of the paint in another disposable container such as a gallon milk jug (cut the top off the milk jug to have a larger opening).
- Then pour a small amount of the absorbent into the container and stir until the paint is absorbed and is no longer liquid.
- If the paint is still liquid, add more absorbent and stir until the kitty litter absorbs all the paint.
- When all the paint is absorbed, place the container of dried paint into the gray refuse Toter.

Lowes and Home Depot sell an absorbent product that can be added to a can of paint to solidify the paint and then the solidified paint can be safely disposed of in regular refuse collection.



LATEX PAINT

Habitat for Humanity accepts latex paint for recycling. These collected paints are blended and sold in the Habitat for Humanity ReStore.

- There is a fee for recycling: \$2 per can (gallon and smaller) and \$5 per five gallon size.
 - All paint must be in the original container.
 - DO NOT mix paints together.



OIL PAINT & PAINT THINNER

Oil paint and paint thinner are HHW because they are petroleum products and can only be disposed of at these locations. Fees are charged.

TUBE FLUORESCENT LIGHT BULBS

All fluorescent light bulbs contain mercury vapor and need to be handled carefully. These bulbs can be recycled at:

INKJET CARTRIDGES

These local businesses recycle inkjet cartridges:

PLASTIC BAGS

All grocery stores and big box stores recycle plastic shopping bags.



SMALL ELECTRONICS & SMALL ELECTRIC APPLIANCES

- Perrysburg Area Drop-Off Recycling at the Perrysburg Township Complex at 26609 Lime City Road on the third Saturday of each month from 9 a.m. - noon.
- City of Perrysburg residents can drop off small electronics at the Perrysburg Department of Public Service at 11980 Roachton Road during regular business hours.
- NO televisions or CRT monitors at either location.



TELEVISIONS

- Environmental Recycling in Bowling Green accepts televisions for recycling at \$.75 per pound.



YARD WASTE

Use the Pay-As-You-Throw yard waste program. Curbside collection using generic paper yard waste bags, bundled brush or resident owned Toters with appropriate collection tag attached. Consult the city web page at www.ci.perrysburg.oh.us for details.

HHW

Includes but not limited to:

- Adhesives
- Aerosol cans (full or empty)
- Caulking
- CFL and tube fluorescent light bulbs
- Driveway sealer
- Gasoline and gasoline mixed with oil
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- Kerosene
- Non-digital fever thermometers
- Non-digital furnace thermostats
- Oil based paints
- Paint thinner
- Pesticides
- Pool chemicals
- Shellac
- Stains
- Varnish



PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS & OVER THE COUNTER (OTC) DRUGS

DO NOT flush drugs and other medications down the toilet or pour down the sink drain. Residents may safely dispose of expired or unwanted at one of the following disposal locations which are available year round, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

- These sites only accept capsules, medication patches, pills or tablets.
- They **DO NOT** accept inhalers, lancets, ointments, liquid medications, syringes, or illegal drugs.
- Keep medication in original containers.
- If pills are in bubble packs, remove the pills from the bubble packs, place pills in a sealed plastic bag.

Safe Method of Medication Disposal at Home

Crush pills/tablets, pour liquid medicine and ointments into kitty litter or used coffee grounds. Place the medication in a sealed container for trash collection.



SYRINGES, SHARPS & LANCETS

DO NOT place Sharps loose in your household trash as this poses a health risk to sanitation workers.

The EPA suggests these three disposal options for used hypodermic needles, lancets and syringes:

- Use a home needle destruction device that clips, melts or burns the needle and allows residents to place the syringe or plunger in regular household trash.
- All sharps, needles and lancets must be placed in a stiff plastic container (bleach or laundry detergent bottles only) with the lid secured, marked as Sharps and placed in the trash NOT recycling.
- Use a Sharps container purchased at your pharmacy. Some containers have a mail back label; if not, the container may be placed in household trash.
