THANKSGIVING

City offices will be closed Thursday, November 25th and Friday, November 26th. There will be a ONE day delay for Thursday and Friday refuse, recycle, and yard waste routes.

**LAST ROUND OF CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION BEGINS
NOVEMBER 29TH**

If you have leaves that fall after the final round of curbside leaf collection, residents may choose one of the following options:

- Take leaves to Renewed Outdoors for free disposal
- Use the Pay-As-You-Throw Yard Waste Curbside Collection
- Use mulched leaves as winter bedding in flower and vegetable gardens
- Start a backyard compost bin for leaves and food waste

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

A reminder that curbside yard waste recycling switches to an on-call once weekly Wednesday ONLY collection. If you have bagged yard waste or yard waste in your personal Toter, call Modern Disposal at 419.874.2966 and leave a message with your address so you can be placed on that week's collection schedule.

RECYCLING UPDATES

GLASS RECYCLING UPDATES

During the month of October, 5.77 tons of glass were collected at the two City of Perrysburg drop-off locations (11980 Roachton Road and 211 East Boundary) and from the three downtown restaurants (Swig, Stella and 5th Street Pub).

CURBSIDE RECYCLING QUESTIONS TO ASK YOURSELF

- Is it a bottle or container?
- Is it plastic, paper, cardboard, metal or aluminum?
- Did it hold food or beverage for humans or pets?
- Did it hold fluids that were used for personal body care, laundry, bathroom or kitchen use?

All items MUST be CLEAN and DRY.

If you are not certain if an item can be recycled, refer to the sticker on your city-issued Toter. You may also consult the A - Z Resource listed on the home page of the city website: www.ci.perrysburg.oh.us.

Remember: IF IN DOUBT...THROW IT OUT

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED IN CITY CURBSIDE RECYCLING

ALUMINUM FOIL

- Aluminum foil and cookware is no longer accepted for curbside recycling. Place in the gray refuse Toter.
- Take foil to the Bowling Green Recycling Center for recycling. The aluminum cookware can be placed in their scrap metal recycling roll off dumpster.

GLASS

- No longer accepted curbside
- Take drinking glasses, bottles and jars to one of the three glass recycling drop-offs in Perrysburg

HARDBACK BOOKS

- Use the drop-off recycling at the Department of Public Service to recycle hardback books

PET FOOD BAGS

- These bags are lined with plastic and cannot be recycled

PLASTIC CONTAINERS THAT HELD HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

- NO motor oil bottles
- NO antifreeze
- NO poisons
- NO herbicides, pesticides
- Take these HHW items to Environmental Recycling in Bowling Green

PLASTIC BAGS

- Take to grocery stores for recycling

PLASTIC PACKAGING WRAP FROM BOTTLED WATER AND BOTTLED DRINKS

- This plastic packaging can be recycled at grocery stores with shopping bags

SHREDDED PAPER

- No longer accepted curbside
- Place in a sealed bag in the gray refuse Toter

STRAWS

- Straws are made from a combination of plastic types and cannot be recycled



2021 LARGE ITEM DISPOSAL

When you have items that are too large to fit in the gray refuse Toter, please follow these guidelines:

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS SET TO THE CURB TWO (2) FEET FROM TOTERS

- Usable items such as furniture and other durable goods, when set to the curb, can be picked up by residents.
- If you do not want to set usable items to the curb, you may donate them to local agencies. Contact them directly for their specific guidelines and what items they accept. Consult the A-Z Resource on the city web site.

MATTRESS AND BOX SPRINGS

- Each of these items **MUST** be wrapped separately in plastic and sealed to keep items from absorbing moisture from rain, snow or the ground.

SCRAP METAL SET TO THE CURB

- Metal scrappers may take the metal items. Please set out items only one day before your regular collection rather than the day after.
- Do not place scrap metal items in the recycle Toter. City crews cannot take them.

YARD WASTE BAGS AND YARD WASTE TOTERS

- Yard waste must be placed to the curb by 7:00 a.m. of collection day or the earliest set out is the night before collection after 6:00 p.m.
- Do not set out before these times as paper yard waste bags absorb moisture and tear if wet when collected.

REMEMBER, CITY CREWS DO NOT COLLECT ANY TYPE OF CONSTRUCTION OR REMODELING DEBRIS. The resident is responsible for proper disposal at one of the area landfills. Lowe's sells one-use dumpster bags with service through Waste Management.

- NO toilets, bathtubs, sinks, showers
- NO plumbing, electrical supplies
- NO drywall, lumber
- NO shingles, siding, roofing
- NO bricks, concrete, pavers, cinder blocks, stones
- NO fences
- NO flooring (except carpet and padding)
- NO cupboards, countertops

MAILBOX CHECK

The City of Perrysburg sends a friendly reminder to all Perrysburg residents that now is the time to check your mailbox to ensure that it will withstand the winter snows. Please be reminded that the City of Perrysburg does not repair any mailboxes that are damaged as a result of snow and/or ice or any other object dispersed by the snowplow. It is the homeowners' responsibility to maintain their mailbox.

Mailboxes should not overhang any curb or pavement surfaces used as part of the travel lanes. The City will only replace/repair mailboxes that are actually hit by the snowplow, but will not repair any mailboxes which overhang the curb or edge of pavement, or have rotted at the base.
