MIXED RECYCLING ACCEPTED CURBSIDE:



PAPER

- Clean, Dry Newspaper (all sections)
- Magazines and Catalogs
- Paperback Books
- Phone Books
- Office Paper (all colors)
- Junk Mail
- **NO SHREDDED PAPER**



MIXED PLASTICS (#1, #2, #4, #5, #6, & #7)

- Look for a number inside the recycle logo
- Plastic Bottles & Jars - CAPS ON
 - > Examples: Milk Jugs, Detergent & Shampoo Bottles, Plastic Pop/Water Bottles, Plastic Jars, Laundry Supplies
- Plastic Containers - LIDS ON
 - > Examples: Yogurt Containers, Butter Tubs, Cottage Cheese Containers
- NO BULKY PLASTIC
 - > Examples: Toys, Crates, Buckets, Pipes, etc.
- NO PLASTIC WRAP



CARDBOARD/PAPERBOARD

- Corrugated Cardboard (wavy center)
- Paperboard (cereal boxes, dry-food boxes, etc.)
- Empty and flatten all boxes
- Remove all packing materials



PAPER FOOD CONTAINERS

- Milk and Ice Cream Cartons
- Juice and Broth Boxes
- PAPER Egg Cartons ONLY
- Cereal, Frozen Food Boxes, and other Paperboard Containers



ALUMINUM & STEEL CANS

- Rinse clean and drain completely
- DO NOT SMASH

THESE ITEMS ARE NOT COLLECTED CURBSIDE



NO Glass



NO Plastic Bags
or Plastic Wrap



DO NOT Bag Recyclables
(no garbage)



NO Food or Liquid
(empty all containers)



NO Foam Packaging
or Containers



NO Yard Waste



NO Shredded Paper



NO Scrap Metal
